

Weeklong adventure in Baltimore-D.C.

The Gunnison Arts Center and Grand Junction's Museum of Western Colorado are co-sponsoring a week-long adventure to a myriad of arts and cultural sites in Baltimore and Washington, DC beginning May 18. And if you are a member of the Arts Center, you will receive a \$50 discount.

The group will travel by air to Washington on Sunday, May 18. The planned itinerary in D.C. includes (but won't be limited to) The National Archives, a special tour of the Library of Congress as well as its American Folklife Center, The Museum of the American Indian, The Smithsonian "Castle", The Air & Space Museum, The Hirshhorn Sculpture Museum.

The itinerary in Baltimore includes a walking tour of Historic Fells Point, Little Italy, The Baltimore Aquarium, The Walters Art Gallery, The African-American Museum, The Irish Shrine/Railroaders Museum, The U.S.S. Constellation, built in 1854. Don't expect to be using tour buses. This is a trip for people who enjoy exploring cities on foot.
