

# GUNNISON ARTS CENTER

The Gunnison Arts Center (GAC) is taking all precautions in order to provide safe and quality programming to you this summer. New procedures will need to be followed by all parents and participants held on the GAC campus. Please read and follow these requirements for participation in summer programming:

- Pre-registration and payment **must be** completed prior to the start of all classes and camps.
- All classes will adhere to the current PHO group size.

- Classes will be held in areas of the GAC where **6 ft. social distancing** can be practiced. Most youth programming will be held outdoors on the courtyard, or inside in the dance studio. Note: Please apply sunscreen to your child before sending them to camp.
- Each student must wear their own clean **face covering** during class. For children, please send them with two clean face coverings each day. Face coverings will not be provided by the GAC. All staff at the GAC will adhere to wearing face coverings.
- **Drop-off and pick-up** for youth camps/classes will be held on the outdoor courtyard located on Hwy 50. Please, do not enter through the front gallery doors.
- Parents and/or caregivers will **check-in** with the instructor when dropping off their child. Parents will be prompt in **picking up** their child from camp or class. If other arrangements need to be made, please call the front desk to reach the instructor. 970-641-4029.
- For youth programming: A basic daily health screening will be recorded by the instructor during drop-off. We ask that all adult students and parents do their part in screening themselves or their child before coming to class each day. If you or your child is showing any symptoms of Covid19, please stay home, and call the GAC to let us know.
- Art Supplies, tools and equipment will not be shared between students and/or instructor. All supplies kept on the GAC campus will be cleaned with approved disinfectant before and after each use.
- Drinking fountains at the GAC will be closed, although the water bottle refill faucet will remain open. Students must bring their own personal water bottles, preferably labeled with their name.
- The GAC staff and instructors will follow the approved Gunnison County Summer Programming guidelines closely and ask that all of our students and participants do so as well. Please review and familiarize yourself here:
